THE COMPLETE ORAL COMMUNICATIONS COURSE: FLUENCY, LISTENING & ACCENT REDUCTION

This course is designed for upper intermediate ESL students (and higher) who wish to improve their overall oral communications skills. This active class includes activities such as discussions, role plays, and oral presentations to increase both the fluency and clarity of your speech, so you will be better understood by others. In addition, a variety of natural listening exercises will help you to better understand spoken English in social, academic, and business situations. The outcome – a more confident communicator in the English language! Required text is announced at the first class.* Prerequisite: Completion of ESL General English Level IV or higher, and an interview with the ESL Advisor.
