Throughout the 2025-2026 academic year, the College achieved significant progress in delivering a high-quality, affordable and accessible education for all students – both within the classroom and beyond.

Notably, the College's reaccreditation with no reporting requirements by the Middle States Commission on Higher Education underscored the College's rigorous academic standards, comprehensive support services, and unwavering commitment to institutional excellence. This, coupled with the financial stewardship of freezing tuition rates for the 2026-2027 academic year, ensured students continue to receive a well-rounded education. Further, the College's launch of a new "MCCC (PA) Legacy Fund" set a framework for ongoing investment in the College's life-changing mission.

The College also expanded many of its hands-on learning opportunities, workforce-connected experiences and partnerships – all efforts geared toward preparing graduates for high demand-high wage careers in Montgomery County and the region. Selection for the prestigious Aspen Institute's Unlocking Opportunity initiative keenly focused our efforts on improving post-completion outcomes for both the workforce and transfer students.

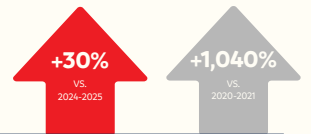
